

Summer Internship Application

Restrictions and Guidelines

For the summer internship to reach its goals, a set of restrictions and guidelines is needed. Much like a plant often needs a trellis to help it grow properly, and a student needs discipline and structure to train him or her in certain skills and techniques, we know that discipline and structure are also needed in the Christian life to perfect us in our service to the Lord. To participate in the summer internship, the participants must be exercised and willing to adhere to the restrictions and guidelines and to carry out a scheduled living. How much profit the internship has in training and perfecting us in our service to the Lord depends upon the degree to which we give ourselves to adhere to the schedule to which we have committed and follow the given restrictions and guidelines.

The following restrictions and guidelines are for full-time participation. Part-time participation will be adjusted according to availability.

1. Interns need to commit to their dates of availability. In the application, the prospective intern must indicate the dates he or she will be available.
2. Interns are encouraged to have a personal time with the Lord in prayer every morning for at least 20 minutes.
3. Interns must participate in all of the summer team coordination meetings and group times. The timing of the meetings will be determined by everyone's availability.
4. Interns are encouraged to attend the weekly church prayer meeting, the Lord's day church meeting, and at least one home meeting a week.
5. Interns should read the Bible and a spiritual ministry book daily (one chapter of the Old Testament, one chapter of the New Testament, and one chapter of a designated ministry book).
6. Interns should participate in team truth pursuit times with an openness to be perfected in knowing the truth.
7. Interns should be willing to receive training and instruction in prayer, gospel preaching, and shepherding others.
8. Interns are expected to go preach the gospel on campus and also participate in manning the club table.
9. Interns should be willingly available for shepherding and visitations of new students.
10. Interns are expected to participate in practical services (i.e. preparing flyers and brochures, arranging club events, organizing club materials, website maintenance, etc.).
11. Interns should fill out weekly schedules that are to be turned in and reviewed with you by the team coordinators.
12. Dress code: during coordination, church meetings, and service times, modest and appropriate dress is expected. You should wear something befitting your service (e.g. no shorts, no inappropriate logos, no sleeveless shirts).
13. If for some reason, due to school or another part-time job, you anticipate that you will not be able to fulfill any of the above requirements, we need to know about this now. A commitment to an agreed upon level of participation is expected.
14. Changes to rules and requirements may be made by the team coordinators as needed.
